#### **SESSION OVERVIEW**

Theme: Becoming gospel-driven people who courageously confront injustice and reflect God's kingdom on earth.

Main Point: Gospel-transformed people are compelled and empowered to be world changers.

**Key Scripture:** Psalm 82:3–4 – "Give justice to the weak and the fatherless; maintain the right of the afflicted and the destitute. Rescue the weak and the needy; deliver them from the hand of the wicked."

#### **OPENING PRAYER (2 min)**

**Invite God's presence** and ask Him to stir in us a holy burden for justice and mercy.

#### Example:

"Father, thank You that You see every injustice and that You care deeply for the vulnerable. Help us see the world through Your eyes. Empower us through Your Spirit to live as agents of justice, mercy, and transformation. Let our hearts be stirred to action, and let our lives reflect Your kingdom. In Jesus' name, Amen."

## HIGHLIGHTS (15 min)

- Where have you seen compassion or justice expressed this week?
- Have you encountered any injustice or stories that stirred your heart?
- What breaks your heart about the world right now—and where do you feel God asking you to act?

Transition with a short prayer of gratitude and a request for open hearts.

#### TIME TO CONSIDER (25 min)

#### Read Psalm 82 Aloud

- Have two volunteers read the passage in different translations.
- Encourage the group to reflect on the following themes
  - · God's rebuke of injustice
  - · His heart for the oppressed
  - His calling on His people to act

#### **Discussion Questions**

# 1. Seeing Injustice Clearly

- What is injustice, according to Psalm 82 and the Bible?
- Why is it important for Christians not to ignore or minimize injustice?
- How does the Bible show us that God isn't okay with the status quo?

#### 2. Understanding Our Role

- What does it mean to be made in God's image and how does that connect to our responsibility for justice?
- How did Jesus model compassion and action for the oppressed?
- Why is the Church uniquely equipped to change the world?

#### 3. Becoming World Changers

- What does a "scarcity mindset" look like in the face of injustice (e.g., the disciples with the 5,000)?
- · How can we move from "looking away" to being people who SEE, BELIEVE, and MAXIMIZE?
- What does it mean to be led by God's Spirit into gospel deeds?

- Identify one way your Life Group can respond to a need locally or globally.
- · Where do you sense God inviting you to be a world changer—in your school, neighborhood, city, or online?

- For eyes to see injustice around us
- For boldness to speak up and act with gospel love
- For Awaken Las Vegas to reflect God's kingdom in word and deed.
- For the global Church to rise in unity to defend, rescue, and restore

# Closing Prayer (10 min)

#### Invite members to:

- Pray over each other—especially for boldness, compassion, and clarity of calling.
- Ask for God's Spirit to lead in strength, not fear
- Consecrate the group to be used for His justice and glory.

- Daily Posture Look, listen and act like Jesus did..
- Speak Up Be a voice for the voiceless in your sphere of influence
- Trust the Power You don't need to change the world alone—just say yes to God's next step.
