

Week 16 | JESUS HAS THE AUTHORITY TO MAKE YOU FREE | John 8:31-36

TO KNOW THE TRUTH MEANS TO KNOW JESUS

A 21st-century Jewish Rabbi made this statement about the power of words: "Words are singularly the most powerful force available to humanity." And to a degree, I think he was right. When the General yells "charge," the military unit goes to battle. When the doctor says, "It's a girl," you are wrapped around a little finger for the rest of your life. When the pastor says, "I pronounce you man and wife," there is a beautiful and supernatural work of God in that moment that causes the two to become one. But with that said, no one's words are more powerful than Jesus'. Just ask the woman who was caught in adultery what she felt when Jesus said to her, "Neither do I condemn you; go, and from now on, sin no more." Jesus' words are especially powerful, well, because they are His. Did you know the Bible says that the whole universe is upheld by the word of His power? Jesus' words have the power to set people free, and that is exactly what every human being needs; to be set free from the power of sin. In a society that has abandoned truth, we need His truth more than ever. And when we really receive His truth, it is then that we will know true freedom.

Leaders: Take your group through each section: Pray, Reflect, and Reach. Keep in mind the time allowances. In the Reflect section, feel free to focus on several of these questions instead of all as time allows.



PRAY (10 min)

As a Life Group, take time to reflect and pray over this weekend's message. Think specifically about how Christ's truth has set you free. Spend time thanking Him.



REFLECT (25 min)

As you've had the opportunity to reflect on what God has spoken to you through the lesson this week, consider these questions as a group and discuss them.

- 1. When it comes to truth, our society is a spiritual warzone, and what our culture proclaims as freedom is, more often than not, enslavement. Discuss examples of how you battle against this darkness and support one another with words of prayer and encouragement.
- 2. While the secular culture would say truth is unknowable, Jesus was clear that truth existed and that it was knowable. **What is truth? How is it knowable? Describe your own experience with Christ and His truth.**

3. What does Jesus' truth set you free from? How does it set you free (what place do faith and obedience have)? Discuss this as a group. Discuss how you have experienced His liberating power, and also discuss areas where you still need to walk in the victory.
