

EXPECT GOD

PASTOR FERNANDO | 2 THESSALONIANS 2:13-17

BOUNDARIES ARE GOOD, BUT NOT WHEN IT COMES TO VISION FOR LIFE, MUCH LESS WHEN IT COMES TO WHAT GOD IS AND WHAT HE CAN DO IN AND THROUGH US.

A story is told about the city fathers of New York as they contemplated the future growth of the city. They laid out the streets and numbered them from the center outward. When they began, there were only six or seven streets. In their planning maps, they projected how large they thought the city might grow. Reaching beyond their wildest imagination, they drew streets on the map all the way out to 19th street. They called it "Boundary Street" because they were sure that's as large as New York City would become. But history has proven them to be shortsighted. At the last count, the city had reached 284th Street – far exceeding their expectations!

Are you expecting God for great things? Or, have you placed God on Boundary Street? You see, God is worthy of your highest expectations, because when we place our expectations in who God is, and what He can do, he'll never disappoint. In fact, God wants you to have an upgraded trust and faith that will lead you to a pleasurable anticipation of God regardless of your circumstances.

Leaders: Take your group through each section: Pray, Reflect, and Reach. Keep in mind the time allowances. In the Reflect section, feel free to focus on several of these questions instead of all as time allows.



Pray as a group with the expectation that He is with you and that He is going to move in a special way during your meeting. Give thanks because He is worthy of your trust.



As you've had the opportunity to reflect on what God has spoken to you through the lesson this week, consider these questions as a group and discuss them.

1. According to the teaching, what do you think you need to maintain a life of pleasant anticipation in God?

- 3. In your own words, explain what the next statement means and why it is important for us to understand: "God's faithfulness promised in his Word is not always how we expect his faithfulness to look."
- 4. Is there an area of your life that needs God's intervention? Share it with your group, and pray expecting God to unleash His life-giving power over you and your circumstances.
