The Misappropriation of Worship

Leaders: Take your group through each section: Pray, Reflect, and Reach. Keep in mind the time allowances. In the Reflect section, feel free to focus on several of these questions instead of all as time allows.



Pray as a group with the expectation that He is with you and that He is going to move in a special way during your meeting. Give thanks because he is worthy of your trust and surrender.



REFLECT (25 min)

As you've had the opportunity to reflect on what God has spoken to you through the lesson this week, consider these questions as a group and discuss them.

- 1. We were created to worship, so if its not God, our worship is missdirected to things that are not worthy. This happens subtly and easily. Discuss how this has been true for you and when you realized you were
- 2. If Satan can get us to replace God's emphatic, periods with satanically inspired question marks, he succeeds at cracking open the door to usher in his greater lies and deceptions just like he did with Eve. What are some ways we can combat his tactics and withstand his temptations like Jesus did in the wilderness?
- 3. What are some truths from Scripture that are God's emphatic periods..that would be helpful to remember. Grab your Bible and share some of God's truths about who we are to Him and use them to encourage each other.
